BE IT REMEMBERED that the Commissioners' Court of Wood County, Texas met in regular session on the date and time last written, with the following members present:

Judge Jeanes presided for the following business, to-wit:

**1. CONSIDER ADOPTION OF THE WOOD COUNTY FY 201\* BUDGET INCLUDING SPECIAL BUDGETS AND FUNDS.**

Judge Jeanes called the court into Special Session at 10:00 a.m.

Judge Jeanes identified the first agenda item as the Wood County FY 2018 Budget including Special Budgets and Funds.

Commissioner Gaskill made a motion to approve the adoption of the Wood County FY 2018 Budget including Special Budgets and Funds. Commissioner Holland seconded the motion. Members voting in favor included Judge Jeanes, Commissioner Holland, Commissioner Gaskill, Commissioner Simmons and Commissioner Acker; motion carried.

WHEREFORE it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the adoption of the Wood County FY 2018 Budget including Special Budgets and Funds are HEREBY APPROVED.

**2. CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE TAX RATE ADOPTION.**

Judge Jeanes read the Resolution Setting Wood County, Texas Tax Rate for 2017.

The motion reads:

“I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.5899.”

Commissioner Holland made a motion that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.5899. Commissioner Simmons seconded the motion and all members voted “aye”.

WHEREFORE it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.5899 is HEREBY APPROVED.

**3. RECORD VOTE TO RAISE MORE REVENUE FROM PROPERTY TAXES THAN IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR.**

Judge Jeanes read the Motion of Ratification.

Commissioner Acker made a motion to ratify the property tax increase reflected in the budget which raises more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year. Commissioner Simmons seconded the motion and all members voted “aye”.

WHEREFORE it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the motion to ratify the property tax increase reflected in the budget which raises more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year is HEREBY APPROVED.
