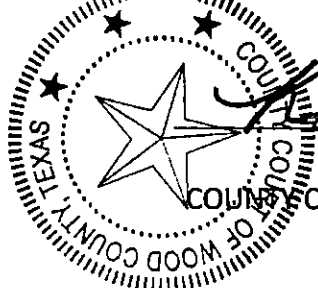
ADJOURN
