Tully Davidson, EMC, informed the court on the updates of House Bill 3000 Rural Ambulance Service Grant. Mr. Davidson said the State had awarded Wood County with \$350,000.00 for UT Ambulance but that he was still waiting on sub-agreement from the State before moving forward.

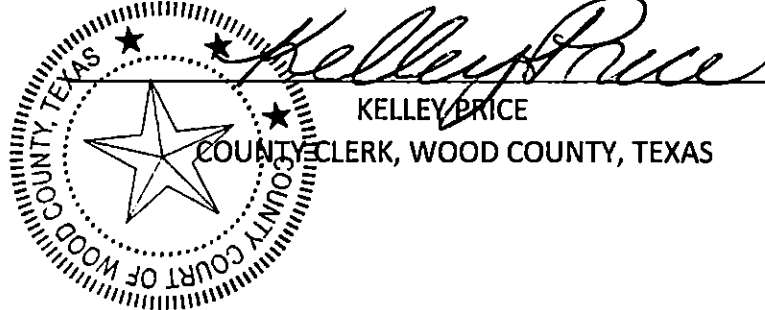
ADJOURN
