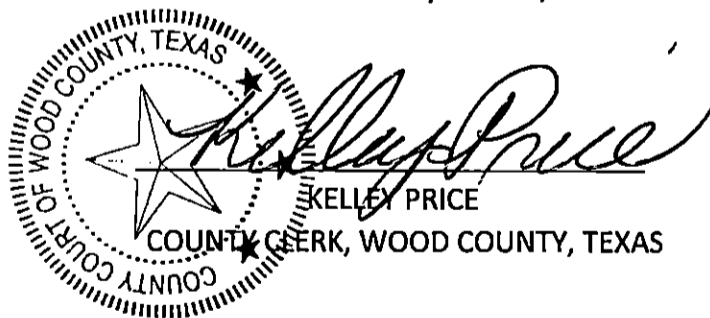
ADJOURN
