

**ANNOUNCEMENT FROM WOOD COUNTY JUDGE LUCY HEBRON**  
**REGARDING THE COUNTY COURT DOCKET**

Based upon recommendations and Orders received from the Office of Court Administration and the Texas Supreme Court, the Wood County Court will be postponing all non-essential hearings. Exceptions will include mental health proceedings, temporary guardianships, plea hearings for defendants who are in custody, and other select hearings that are considered essential. At this time, the following hearings will proceed as scheduled:
