ORDER OF THE WOOD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT RATIFYING THE ORDER CLOSING WOOD COUNTY BEACHES DURING THE COVID-19 DISASTER

WHEREAS, on April 16, 2020, Wood County Judge Lucy Hebron, acting in accordance with the power and authority vested in her by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Texas, issued an Order Closing Wood County Beaches during the COVID-19 Disaster ("Order"); and

WHEREAS, such an order may not be continued for a period of more than seven (7) days, except with the consent of the Commissioners' Court; and


WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating the issuance of the Order will continue to exist for a period of more than seven (7) days; and

WHEREAS, the Wood County Commissioners' Court supports the Order signed by Wood County Judge Lucy Hebron on April 16, 2020 and consents to its continuation for a period of 14 days from the date of its expiration of April 24, 2020, resulting in a new expiration date of May 8, 2020, unless further extended by the Wood County Commissioners' Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE WOOD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT:

1. The Order Closing Wood County Beaches during the COVID-19 Disaster signed by County Judge Lucy Hebron is hereby ratified; and
2. Consent is given to the continuation of the Order for a period of an additional 14 days.
