### **COVID-19 Update**

As of 2:30 p.m. on April 29, 2020, one additional confirmed, positive case of Coronavirus (COVID-19) has been reported for Wood County, Texas, bringing the total for the county to eight (8) confirmed, positive cases.

Texas Health and Human Services is offering mobile COVID-19 test collection for Wood County on May 1, 2020, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Mineola Civic Center, which is located at 1150 N. Newsom, Mineola, Texas. Registration will open 24 hours prior to the mobile test collection beginning, which will be by appointment only.
